Happy New Year! I wish each of you and your families the most blessings that 2023 has to offer in your personal and professional lives.

Despite the craziness and occasional instability in the world that we often read about in the news, far more went right for JRCC in 2022 than went wrong:

- Membership is up to just over 630 members with the addition of 75 members, many of whom are young couples with young children who have contributed to a vibrant atmosphere and bolstered our River Ratz swim team, Junior Golf and summer camps;
- The upper and lower pools were crystal clear and functioned properly (Thank you to Past President Jeff Verhoef and Watersports Committee Chair Josh Dornan for their tireless efforts in getting us there);
- Our golf course offered members and guests 20,480 rounds of beautiful golf on one of the nicest 18-hole courses we will find;
- Racquet Sports hosted a Tennis and Pickleball Club Championship that we hope will continue as an annual tradition;

- Hundreds of member-hosted events were held at our Club for members and guests, showcasing the talents of Chef Matt and the positive energy of our banquet team.

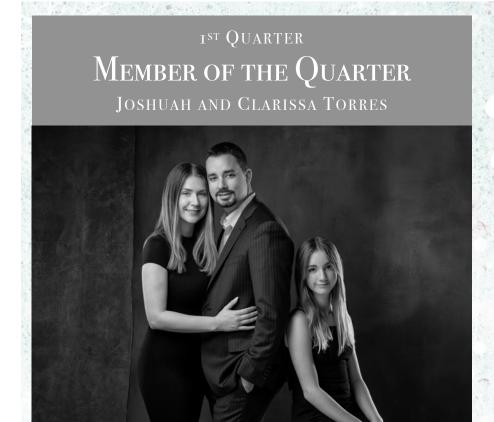

RULES AND POLICIES REMINDER

James River Country Club is a traditional, family-oriented private club with a proud history, rich traditions, and commitment to the customs of southern hospitality and gracious living. As such, all members and their guests are asked to adhere to a certain level of decorum – attire should be appropriate for the venue. While JRCC is perhaps less formal than some other country clubs, certain areas within the Club Grounds have very specific dress code policies.

Thank you in advance for being considerate of all members and guests.

TENNIS ATTIRE

- Appropriate tennis attire must be worn at all times.
- Proper tennis attire is defined as apparel specifically designed for tennis and can include clothing made of moisture-wicking "dri-fit" material.
- Men and boys are not permitted to wear sleeveless shirts.
- All players must wear regulation tennis shoes on the Club courts.
- Cross-training, basketball, and jogging shoes are not permitted. Black-soled shoes are not permitted in the indoor facility.
- Swimwear, halter tops, strapless blouses, denim, cut-offs, T-shirts (traditionally worn as undergarments or with offensive logos or messages), and lycra spandex garments as an outer layer are not appropriate attire on the tennis courts and are not permitted.

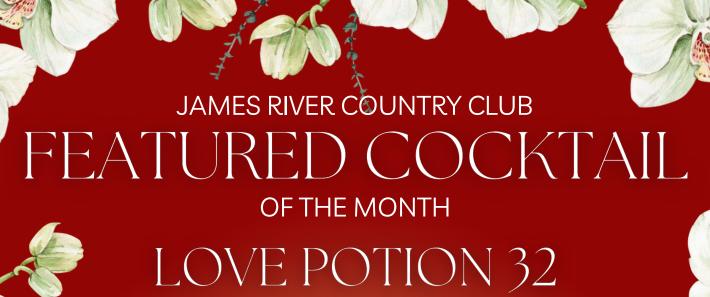
