Golf & Grounds Maintenance Report

Report by Rob Wilmans, Director of Golf & Grounds Maintenance

ow! The winter projects are coming to an end and the facility is looking awesome! The construction part of the bunker project is over and now we are tasked with growing in the turf. The sod around the bunkers is looking great, with new roots being initiated and plants greening up nicely. There will be some weed encroachment in the new sod since we were unable to get all of our pre-emergent down in time to be effective. We will be treating them, and once we get on a regular mowing program, they will not be so obvious. The construction actually finished ahead of schedule and under budget! Total Turf Golf Services were awesome to work with and did a first-class job for us here at JRCC. There were only a few minor hiccups along the way, but all in all a much easier project than expected.

The work behind the clubhouse has been completed, again with great results. The new lawn looks like it has always been there and the new expanded cart path now lets us have access behind the clubhouse and allows for golfers to have a better experience playing number 18. As this article is coming out, we should be in the process of installing new landscape material in front of the clubhouse. This is a very exciting project and along with the freshly painted building should serve to give our façade a much-needed facelift!

Regular golf maintenance is still on schedule and the mild winter has brought the fairways in without any noticeable winter kill. What a change from last year!! We have been trying to mow everything short in an effort to green up the turf as quickly as possible. Fairways are being mowed at 3/8ths of an inch and rough at around 1.25". We will bring the rough up to 1.5" once we get around the course at the shorter height. Greens did well through the spring aeration and are on schedule to being healed completely the first week of May. I am optimistic that we will have great playing conditions this season and continue to elevate the level of the golf experi-


